Take part in shaping Europe's sustainable energy future



„Sustainable Energy Day“ Gori City 4 June, 2015

On 4 June, 2015 in Gori City was commemorated Sustainable Energy Day, 2015. The event was conducted within “CoM Grant Project” financed by EU Commission and “Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency New Project” financed by BP Georgia and its co-ventures.

Sustainable Energy Day in Gori was full of various events, such as Commission Event of Demonstration project of Gori Military Hospital, Media Tour for central and local journalists at the Kindergarten #16 and “Electrification” settlement where implemented various Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency Measures. Within “Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency New Project” was opened the demonstration project of solar water heating system installed at The Gori Military Hospital. The event was attended representatives of Gori City Hall, Ministry of Defence of Georgia, BP Georgia and all other stakeholders. Besides, within sustainable energy day was held the media-tour for journalists along with demonstration project of Gori Military Hospital visited Demonstration Project implemented at #16 Gori Kindergarten within “Demonstration Projects for Supporting of Implementation of Sustainable Energy Action Plans in Covenant of Mayors (CoM) Georgian Signatory Cities” and “CoM Grant Project” initiated and co-funded by UNDP/GEF Small Grants Program program, European Commission and Self-governing Gori City. As a result of implemented energy efficient measures has been significantly improved indoor environment for children and has been enabled the kindergarten to reduce energy expenditures – save annually about 85550 kWh compared to baseline and reduce by 17t. CO₂ emissions.

Afterwards of kindergarten the journalists visited the so-called “electrification” settlement located in suburb of Gori City where installed 57 units of LEDs. The project was implemented and financed by Gori City Hall. It should be noted that all implemented activities will assist to Gori city to reduce CO₂ emissions and to promote RE & EE technologies as well as to fulfil the obligations taken under CoM.

In the commemoration of sustainable energy day in Gori city very actively was involved the local population (schoolchildren, parents, journalists and etc). More specific, the schoolchildren of Art and Gymnastic schools participated in street drawing action and performed flash-mob dedicated to sustainable energy day. During the day was widely distributed various information and promotional materials such as leaflets, certificates, T-shirts, caps and bags. The event was widely elucidated in media as well.
