### **Purpose and outcomes of the third RECP training workshop**

The purpose of the online event is to present an overview of assessment results from the UNIDO RECP Training Program in Industry, to summarize findings and showcase recommendations during the RECP assessments, as well as to conclude on the ways forward for the trainees and the assessed companies in Georgia.

The third training workshop will comprise of a one day online training focused at presentations by the trainees' groups (who performed the detailed RECP assessments). The presented reports will contain: analysis of production efficiency, identified RECP opportunities and calculated measures, no- and low-cost measures, and business cases (in other words, the workplan for development and implementation of technically advanced measures). The presentations will be followed by the general feedback of the international and local trainers. The final presentation of RECP in-plant assessments will be presented at a broader event with the participation of representatives from the demonstration companies, RECP experts, RECP Club member companies, and other interested stakeholders.

### **Participants**

The list consists of specialists working in environmental management, engineering (chemical, industrial, environment, or related fields) who decided to be trained on the RECP methods and their applications, as well as the representatives of the demonstration companies which were selected for RECP assessments. The company representatives will be also invited to participate in the event devoted to the discussions of the company related issues. The tentative number of participants for every workshop is about 20 persons.

### **Background**

Resource Efficient and Cleaner Production (RECP) is used as an umbrella term for the application of preventive environmental strategies. The United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO) has developed the RECP methodology that helps to identify sources of losses for all types of resources used by an enterprise, identify the root causes of such losses, and develop and assess the feasibility of activities aimed at reducing or completely eliminating the identified losses. The RECP training and coaching programme aims to provide hands-on experience and advanced training on the application of the RECP methodology, as well as to demonstrate the benefits and opportunities brought forth by RECP.

The Overall Trainings Programme consists of a one-day Information Seminar, two training workshops lasting for two and three days correspondingly, and a third workshop of two days focusing on the results and presentation of In-Plant Assessment Reports as well as coaching activities.
