Background

National RECP Network has been formed upon the completion of the RECP Clubs' Training and Coaching and RECP Training for the Georgian experts programmes as a means of strengthening the national capacity and collaboration on RECP in the country.

The Network was envisioned as platform that will help to expand knowledge and capability of each member, by leveraging relationships with other professionals, enhancing communication and knowledge sharing among experts, business owners, and stakeholders interested in RECP.

For the organization of regular RECP Network meetings (2-3 times per year) to discuss the most interesting issues/topics, to explore local needs, to share national good practice and approaches, to introduce new/updated legislative obligations or standards, to discuss the most topical issues affecting the business sector, etc. a survey among RECP demonstration and RECP Clubs' member companies for the identification and prioritization of topics of interest for the companies. The majority of companies, according to the poll results, expressed interest in getting more detailed information on solar PV technology.
